<b>DEERCREEK TOWNSHIP</b>	A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Deercreek Township (excluding the Village of Williamsport) for the purpose of general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads, and bridges that the county auditor estimates will collect \$79,000 annually, at a rate not exceeding 3 mills for each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$104 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value, for 5 years, commencing in 2023, first due in calendar year 2024.	<b>All Precincts</b>
<b>HARRISON TOWNSHIP</b>	An additional tax for the benefit of Harrison Township (including the villages of Ashville and South Bloomfield) for the purpose of maintaining and operating cemeteries that the county auditor estimates will collect \$120,000 annually, at a rate not exceeding 0.5 mill for each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$18 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value, for 5 years, commencing in 2023, first due in calendar year 2024.	<b>All Precincts</b>
<b>STERLING JOINT AMBULANCE DISTRICT</b>  <b>Overlaps: MADISON AND PICKAWAY COUNTIES</b>	A replacement of a tax for the benefit of the Sterling Joint Ambulance District for the purpose of current expense that the county auditor estimates will collect \$447,000 annually, at a rate not exceeding 1.5 mills for each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$53 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value, for 5 years, commencing in 2024, first due in calendar year 2025.	<b>16/1, 16/2, 16/3</b>
<b>STERLING JOINT AMBULANCE DISTRICT</b>  <b>Overlaps: MADISON AND PICKAWAY COUNTIES</b>	A replacement of a tax for the benefit of Sterling Joint Ambulance District for the purpose of current expense that the county auditor estimates will collect \$447,000 annually, at a rate not exceeding 1.5 mills for each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$53 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value, for 5 years, commencing in 2024, first due in calendar year 2024.	<b>17/1, 18/1, 19/1, 20/1, 21/1, 22/1</b>
<b>TRI-COUNTY JOINT FIRE DISTRICT</b>  <b>Overlaps: MADISON, FAYETTE, AND PICKAWAY COUNTIES</b>	An additional tax for the benefit of Tri-county Joint Fire District for the purpose of current expenses that the county auditor estimates will collect \$316,000 annually, at a rate not exceeding 1.5 mills for each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$53 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value, for 5 years, commencing in 2023, first due in calendar year 2024.	<b>13/1, 14/1, 14/2, 15/1</b>

<b>VILLAGE of NEW HOLLAND</b>  <b>Overlaps: PICKAWAY AND FAYETTE COUNTIES</b>	An additional tax for the benefit of the Village of New Holland for the purpose of current expenses that the county auditor estimates will collect \$13,000 annually, at a rate not exceeding 1 mill for each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$35 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value, for 5 years, commencing in 2023, first due in calendar year 2024.	<b>13/1, 14/1, 14/2, 15/1</b>
<b>VILLAGE of NEW HOLLAND</b>  <b>Overlaps: PICKAWAY AND FAYETTE COUNTIES</b>	A renewal of a tax for the benefit of the Village of New Holland for the purpose of general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads, and bridges that the county auditor estimates will collect \$6,000 annually, at a rate not exceeding 0.7 mill for each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$17 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value, for 5 years, commencing in 2024, first due in calendar year 2025.	<b>01/1, 02/1, 03/1, 04/1, 05/1, 05/2, 06/1, 07/1, 08/1, 09/1</b>
<b>VILLAGE of TARLTON</b>	An additional tax for the benefit of the Village of Tarlton for the purpose of general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads, and bridges that the county auditor estimates will collect \$4,000 annually, at a rate not exceeding 1 mill for each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$35 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value, for 5 years, commencing in 2023, first due in calendar year 2024.	<b>27/1, 30/2</b>
